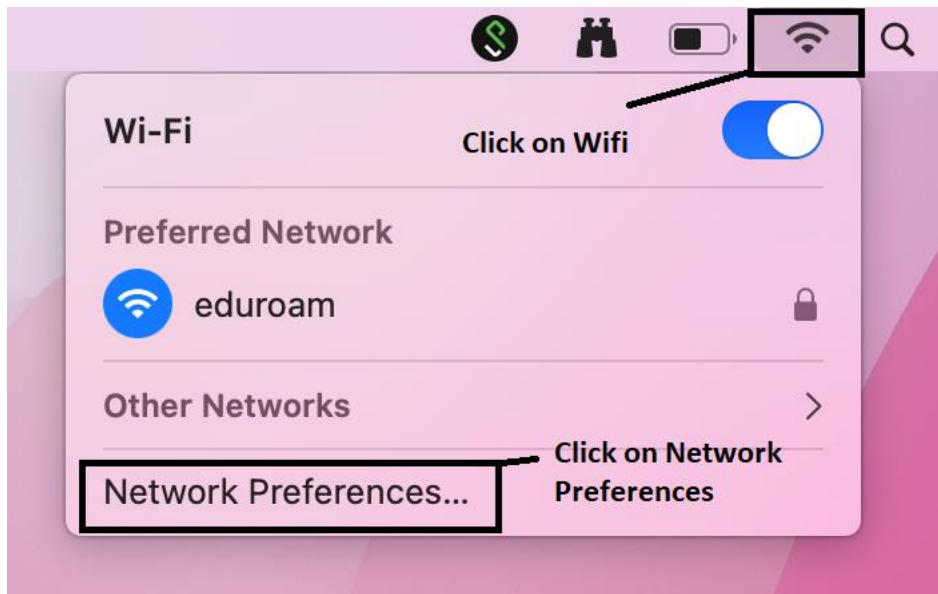
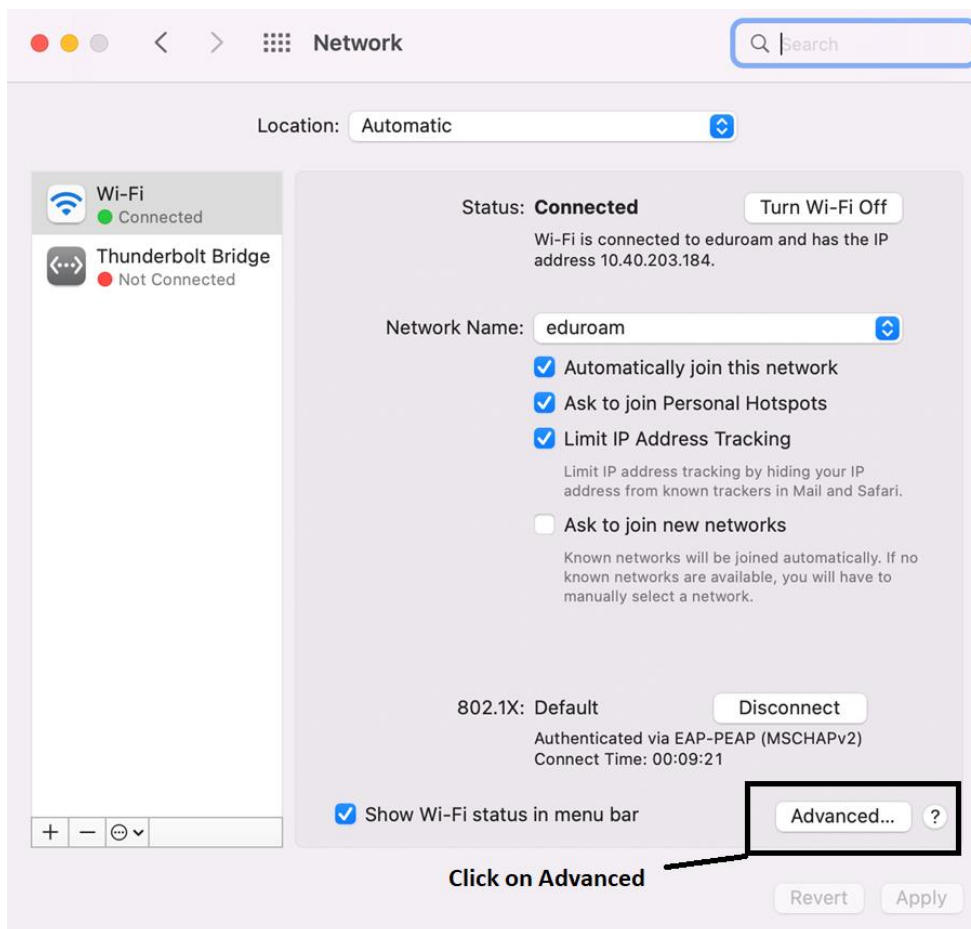


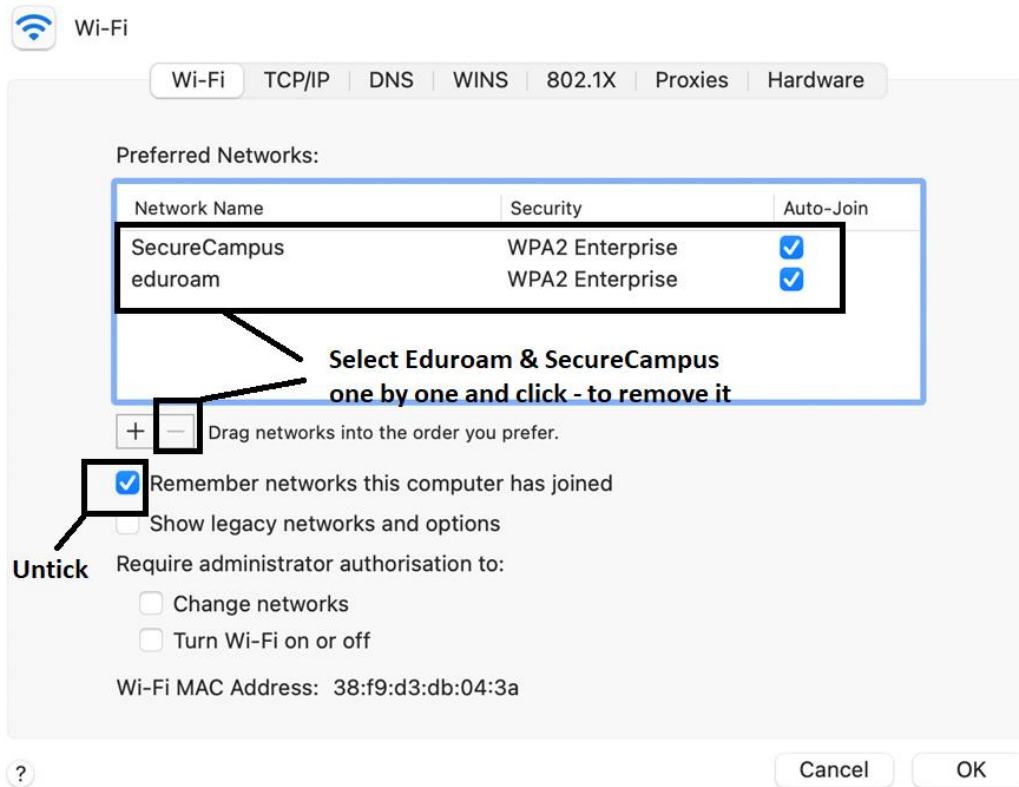
Click the Wi-Fi internet symbol in the top-right corner and then click on Network Preferences



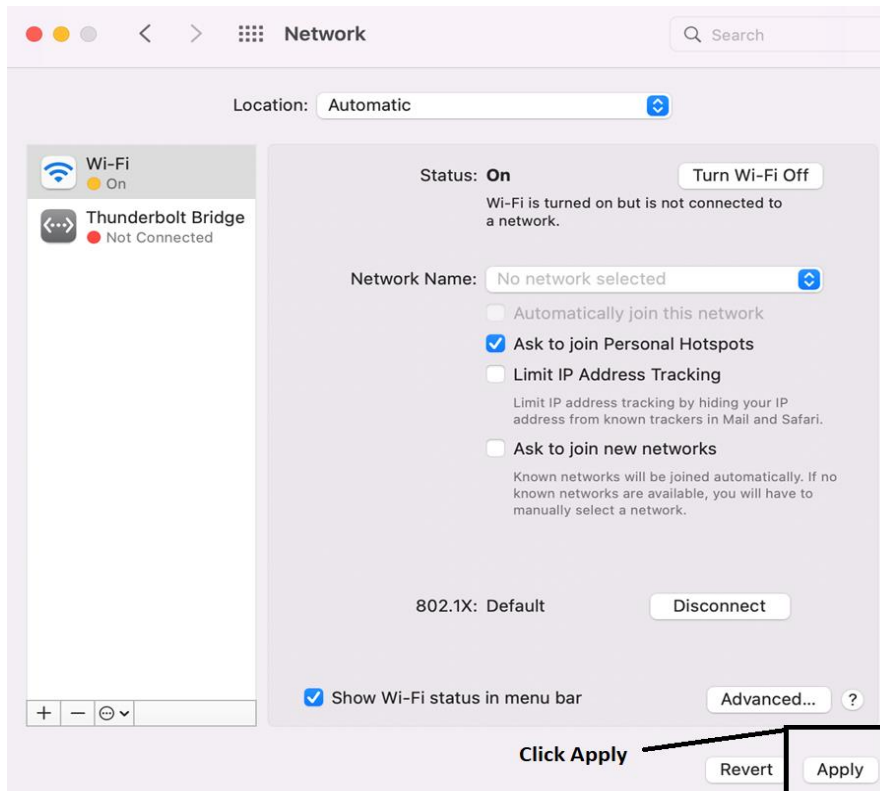
Click on Advanced

 Click ok



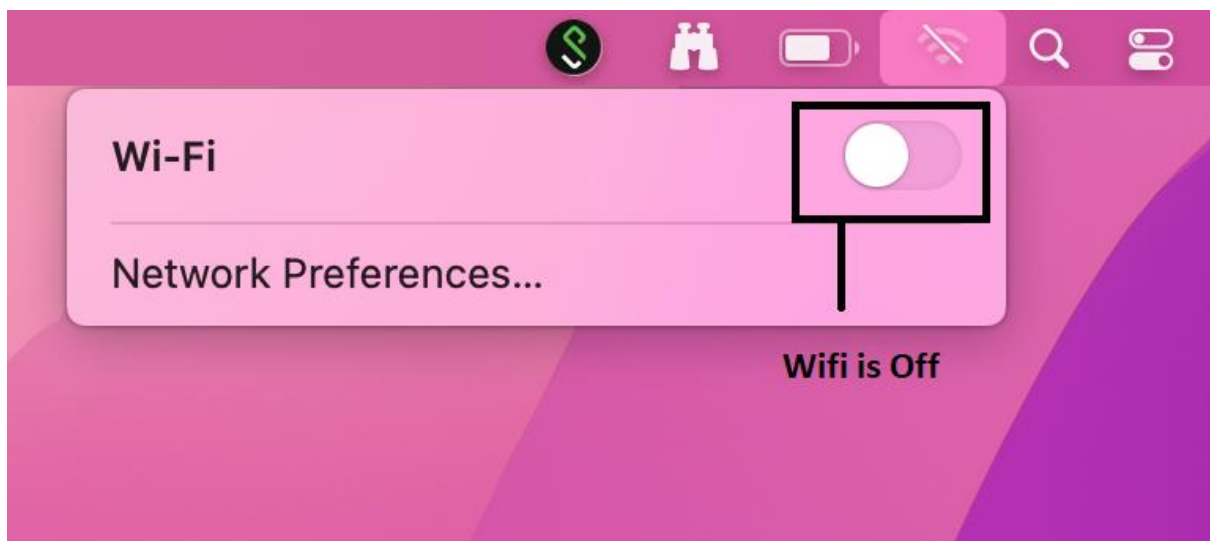
Click Apply



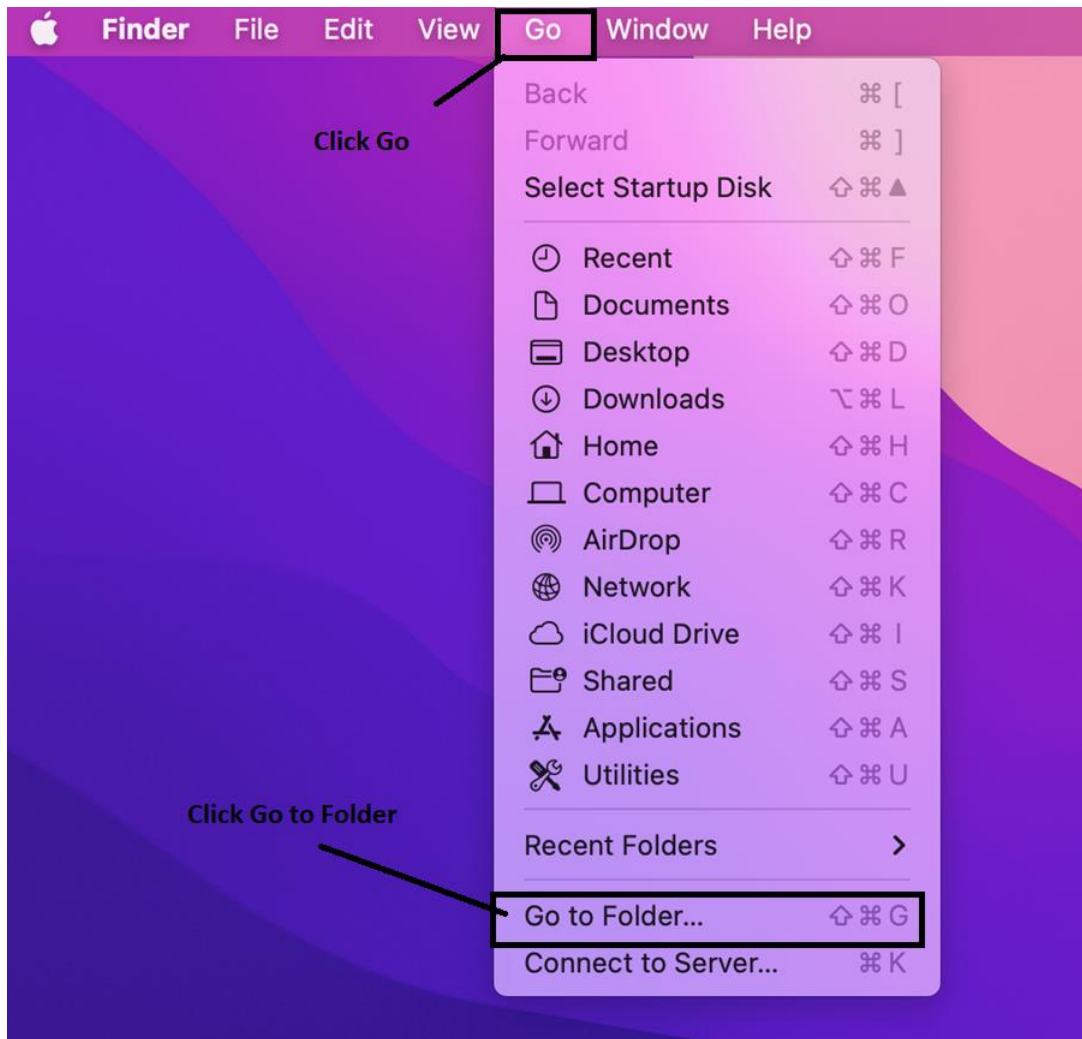
Click the Wi-Fi internet symbol in the top-right corner.



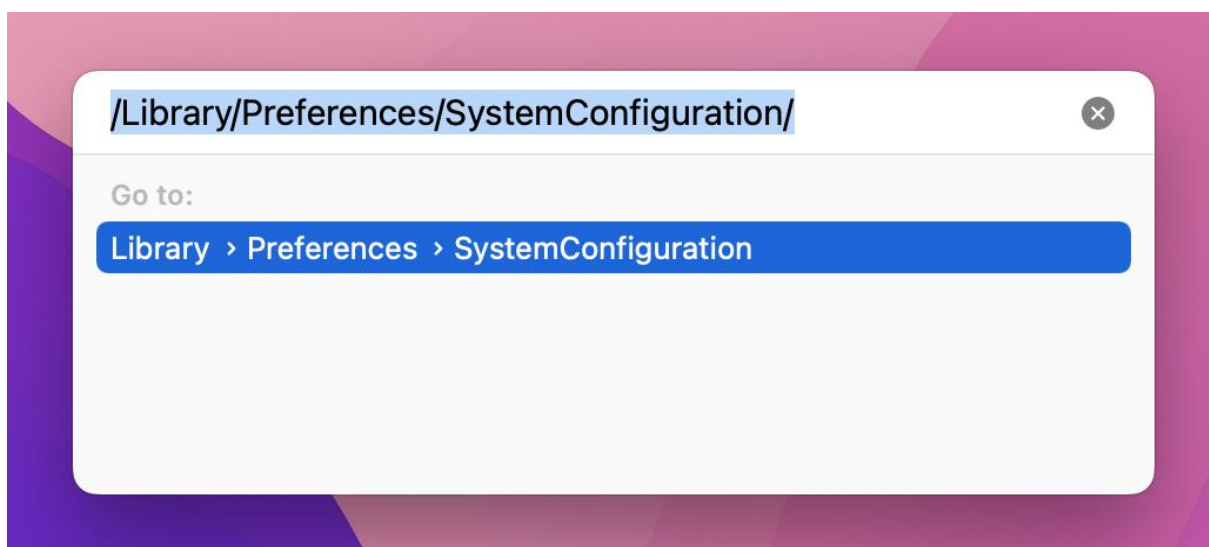
Click the switch to turn Wi-Fi off.



From the Go menu, click Go to Folder



Type `/Library/Preferences/SystemConfiguration/` into the text field and press enter



Select the following five files:

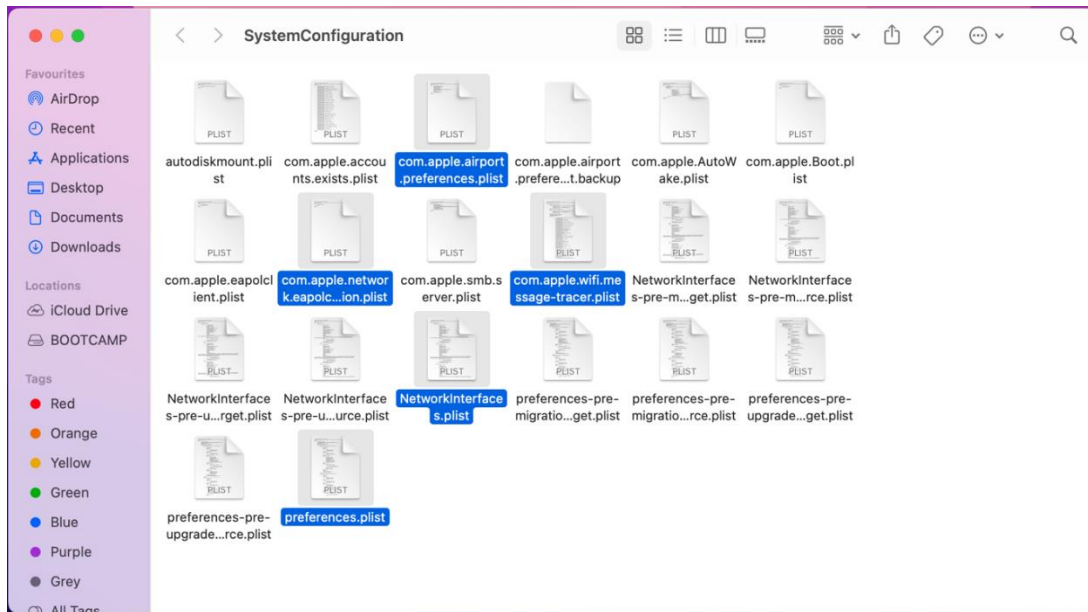
com.apple.airport.preferences.plist

com.apple.network.identification.plist or com.apple.network.eapolclient/configuration.plist

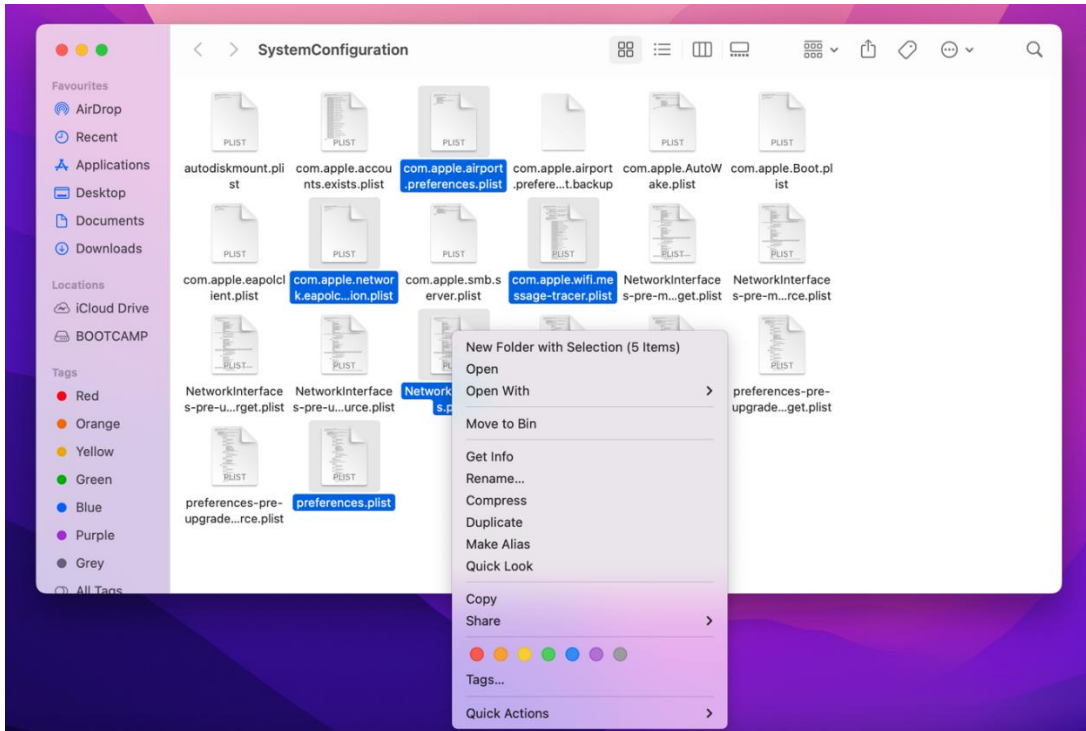
com.apple.wifi.message-tracer.plist

NetworkInterfaces.plist

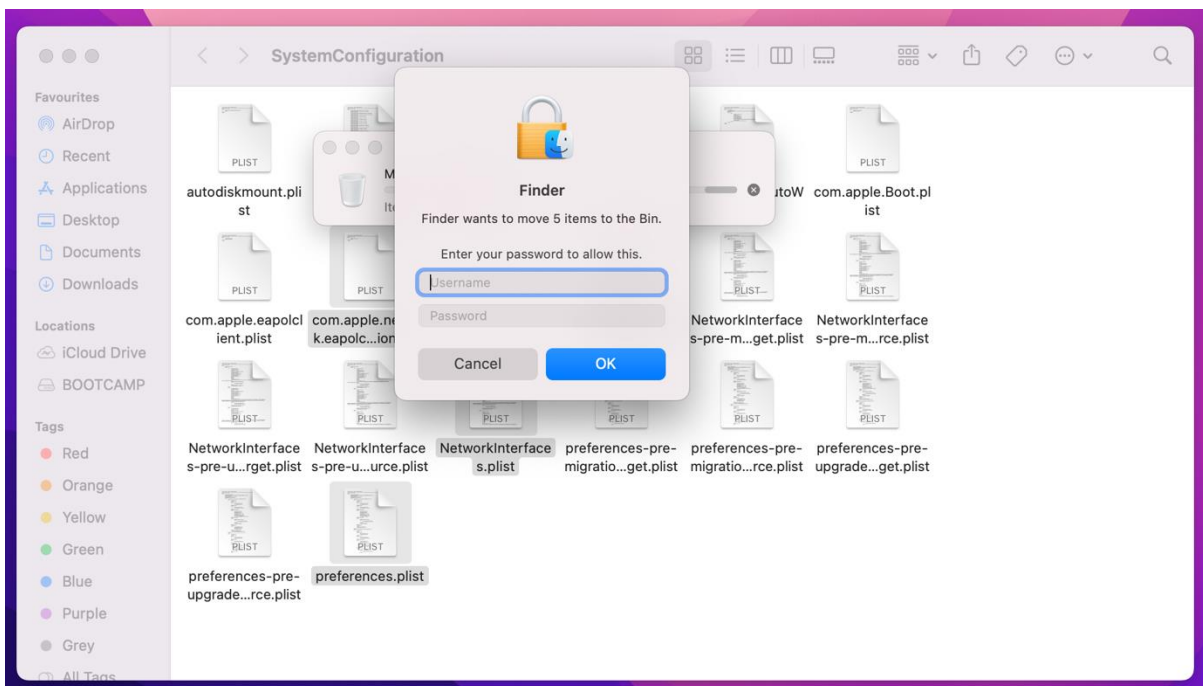
preferences.plist



Right-click the files and select Move to Bin to delete them (First copy all five files to your desktop as a backup just in case)



If prompted to confirm the deletion with a password, do so.



Restart your Mac as usual and turn its Wi-Fi back on. The five deleted files should be recreated within their original location, and all your network settings should now be reset

Now try again to connect to Eduroam / Open Campus with your Lincoln user name and password.

Click Continue to verify certificate for Eduroam / OpenCampus if prompted
